THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY
Trinity Sunday, also known as Holy Trinity Sunday, is celebrated a week after Pentecost Sunday in honor of the most fundamental of Christian beliefs—belief in the Holy Trinity. We can never fully understand the mystery of the Trinity, but we can sum it up in the following formula: God is three Persons in one Nature. The three Persons of God—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—are all equally God, and They cannot be divided.

MISSIONS SUNDAY - on Sunday, June 7th
Fr. Pawel Petelski OMI, a missionary from Madagascar will be visiting our parish. Fr. Pawel will give a homily during every Polish Mass, during which he will talk about his missionary work. As a result of the official visit, there will be a second collection for the development of Catholic missions in Madagascar.

Fr. Pawel Petelski was ordained in 2003 and finished a yearlong course in the Centre for Missionary Formation in Warsaw. In 2004, he joined the mission in Madagascar. Following a few month long course of the Malagasy language in Finarantsoa, he began his work in the biggest mission in Marolambo. The mission consists of 200 Christian communities. All missionaries are travelling between these communities by foot as there are no roads; the area is very mountainous.

A LIVER DONOR FOR DELFINA BUDZIAK –

At 2 months old, Delfina Arianna Budziak was diagnosed with Biliary Atresia. Since her diagnosis, she has undergone a Kasai procedure and has suffered several bouts of cholangitis, an infection of the liver. The day after her Baptism, April 26, Delfina suffered her most recent bout of cholangitis. Since then, she has been at the Hospital for Sick Children in Toronto, waiting for a liver transplant. Delfina is loved by her family- especially her three-year old brother Matthew, cousin Arianna and parents Peter and Betsy. Many family members have undergone testing to be a donor but none have been identified as viable. Delfina's family, inspired by the overwhelming public response to the appeal from Senator's owner Eugene Melnyk, have now turned to the public in hopes of finding a living donor. While Delfina is on the transplant wait-list for a deceased donor, she is currently stabilized by hospitalization and medication, and as such is not at the top of the list. Delfina's donor must be blood type O+.
