



PRIESTHOOD JUBILEE

Today at 11:00am Mass we are celebrating the 25th anniversary of ordination to priesthood of Fr. Adam Filas, OMI.

We welcome Fr. Adam Filas, OMI who will give the homily during the Mass at 11:00am.

While working in a parish, I led a Confirmation retreat for Grade 6 students during which I explained the importance of saying yes to one's faith. Children this age have an immense capacity to imagine; their minds wander easily. While discussing sacraments, the group became distracted by a participant's story of a haunted house. When I asked if the homeowners had used holy water on the house, the storyteller replied, "Yes, but the ghost still would not go away." The class was on edge. Wanting to shift the topic, I said, "If the homeowners didn't have faith, they may as well have tried to clean the house with a mop and a bucket of tap water. It's the same with sacraments. While God always offers grace in the sacraments, they only become active if you are open to receive that grace - much like your "yes" in confirmation and the faith that has grown in you since you were baptized." Later, I recognized the Holy Spirit's message was communicated through my telling the students that even holy water only "works" through faith. Jesus tells the hemorrhaging women that her faith has made her well. He tells a dying child's parents, "Do not fear, only believe." Christ's gift of the saving power of faith allows us all to encounter him sacramentally. Faith allows us to put away the mop.

From the Pulpit

SOLEMNITY OF SAINTS PETER AND PAUL - Monday, June 29th

The Confession of Peter ("Thou art the Christ, the Son of the Living God") is commemorated on 18 January, and the Conversion of Paul (on the approach to Damascus) a week later on 25 January. On June 29th we commemorate the martyrdoms of both apostles. The date is the anniversary of a day around 258, under the Valerian persecution, when what were believed to be the remains of the two apostles were both moved temporarily to prevent them from falling into the hands of the persecutors. The Scriptures do not record the deaths of Peter or Paul, or indeed any of the Apostles except for James the son of Zebedee (Acts 12:2), but they are clearly anticipated, and from an early date it has been said that they were martyred at Rome at the command of the Emperor Nero, and buried there. As a Roman citizen, Paul would probably have been beheaded with a sword. It is said of Peter that he was crucified head downward. The present Church of St Peter in Rome replaces earlier churches built on the same site going back to the time of the Emperor Constantine, in whose reign a church was built there on what was believed to be the burial site of Peter. Excavations under the church suggest that the belief is older than Constantine.
