It can be hard to be a prophet, especially to acquaintances. In today's Gospel, the people of Jesus' hometown reject him. They think they know him. They have a pigeonholed Jesus, the son of Mary, as a simple carpenter. When Jesus defies their expectations of him, they become defensive. Like the Israelites of Ezekiel's Day, they are stubborn: they refuse to accept God's Word. Although their lack of faith amazes him, Jesus remains faithful to his mission, proclaiming the kingdom of God among the villages. We may not consider ourselves prophets, yet because we have been baptized into the life of Christ, we share in the prophetic role. In a unique way, we are all prophets in the hometown spaces of our daily life. Whenever we are faithful to the Gospel's message, we are prophets to our families, friends, co-workers and communities. We may grow disheartened if family members abandon the Church. We may become discouraged if others reject the message and criticize us. We may stumble and doubt ourselves. This is when the sufficiency of God's grace, so powerful for Paul in his struggles, emboldens us to carry on in fidelity. In this Eucharistic celebration, let us give thanks for the grace, for the life of Christ dwelling within us that gives us the courage to be hometown prophets.

What is there to do during the pilgrimage?

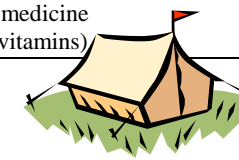
Each day is filled with: praying the rosary, conferences, testimonies of the leaders as well as the participants' of the pilgrimage, singing, and conversation. Attendance at morning Mass is mandatory. In the evening there is time for a bonfire, singing and fun, and sometimes even a soccer game.

What do I bring with me on the pilgrimage?

Supplies:
- tent (it's better to share a tent with friends, there is little room on the farm fields and a lot of tents, we must make use of the space we have wisely)
- warm sleeping bag, blanket
- propane bottle, metal or plastic dishes and utensils, can opener
- water bottle
- cotton socks
- shirts with sleeves
- comfortable (not new!) shoes
- hat
- raincoat, poncho

Cosmetics:

- sunscreen with UV protection
- bathroom supplies
- toilet paper
- mosquito repellent-basic medicine (pain relievers, band aids, vitamins)
