From the Pulpit

Today is the 15th Sunday of Ordinary Time. During the summer vacation let us not forget about celebrating the Holy Day and attending the Sunday Mass.

Let churches be regular stops on our summer paths. In each church, we have an opportunity to meet our Saviour and Lord - Jesus Christ. Let us remember for our behaviour and attire to be appropriate during sightseeing, as well as during celebrating of Holy Mass.

PROCESSION TO THE ROSARY GARDEN Monday, July 13th is following the evening Mass. All parishioners are invited to join in a procession on the 13th of every month from May to October following the evening Mass, in remembrance of the visions of Fatima.

OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL - On Thursday, July 16, we celebrate the feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. This day reminds us of the great privilege of Scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, also known as the Brown Scapular. According to the Vatican's Congregation for Divine Worship, the Brown Scapular is "an external sign of the filial relationship established between the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother and Queen of Mount Carmel, and the faithful who entrust themselves totally to her protection, who have recourse to her maternal intercession, who are mindful of the primacy of the spiritual life and the need for prayer." The Holy Mother promised that those that wear the Brown Scapular will be saved from the purgatory on the first Saturday following their death. Saint John Paul II has a strong devotion of Our Lady of Mount Carmel and wore the Brown Scapular since his youth.

ST. CHRISTOPHER - PATRON OF DRIVERS - July 25th - To commemorate the memorial of St. Christopher, the patron of drivers, everyone will have an opportunity to have their vehicle blessed in the parish parking lot on Sunday, August 16th at 4:00pm (the day of our Parish Feast of our patron St. Maximilian Kobe). St. Christopher was a martyr during the 3rd century and is considered since the patron saint of all drivers, travelers, as well as a patron saint of all those in danger. August - Month of Alcohol Abstinence August is traditionally declared by the Church in Poland as the month of alcohol abstinence. The Church invites everyone to abstain from alcoholic beverages during the month of August. THE LIBERATION CRUSADE is a voluntary commitment to abstain from alcoholic beverages. The term "crusade" indicates a spiritual battle with evil, where prayer is fundamental. Members of the Crusade are committed not only to abstain from drinking, but also to help others who struggle with alcohol addiction. Everyone is invited - especially in the month of August - to join the Crusade and abstain from consuming alcoholic beverages.

A special book will be placed at the altar of the relics, where everyone is welcomed to write their name.

"I am no Prophet." So often we are tempted to repeat the words of Amos that we hear in today's first reading. Yet God's call to us to prophesy is soon underlined in the Gospel, which reminds us again that we are all called to bear witness. The Psalmist, in turn, points out to us how God will respond to our prayers, as we are told that the Lord will give what is good. Perhaps this is a way of reminding us that God's answer to our prayers is always good- even if we do not see that at the time our prayers are answered. With the coming of Christ these two messages take on new meaning. In part, we need to recall that through the Incarnation, God provides an opportunity for an ever-deeper relationship to develop between God and his people. This relationship requires us to take a long-term view of the events of our lives, especially when we reflect on our passing from this world to the next. Taking nothing for the journey is an approach that could be used to guide us as we consider our call to bear witness. This is good advice because, after all, nothing is required for prayer. And in prayer we will find an answer to our questions about our long-term fortunes.
