Many of the elements of the Archdiocese of Toronto's Pastoral Plan require no funding, but

rather the investment of our time and talents. We also need to support key elements of the Pastoral Plan by investing the necessary financial resources. Family of Faith campaigns in all parishes of the archdiocese will help provide those resources.

St. Maximilian Kolbe is launching our Family of Faith campaign, an undertaking to support the Archdiocese of Toronto and all its parishes. This is a collaborative effort; for every dollar we raise toward our goal, 25 cents will stay right here in our parish. If we exceed our goal, the parish will receive 75 cents of every dollar above that amount.

To help fund many initiatives in the Pastoral Plan, the \$105 million Family of Faith campaign will address a number of urgent needs within the church. The most pressing of these needs include:

-Restoring and enhancing the beauty of St. Michael's Cathedral as the mother church of all Catholics in the archdiocese

-Establish a new capital fund to provide financing to new churches and to support those parish communities that may be struggling with significant building issues.

-Supporting Catholic education through campus based ministry to keep our youth engaged in an active life of faith

-Ensuring there is a strong Catholic voice in an increasingly secular world etc.

Every parish in the archdiocese will participate in this project. Each parish has a financial goal. Our parish goal is \$1.5 million dollars.

Over the next several weeks, we will be talking more about our Family of Faith campaign, and what this historic campaign can do for our parish and the archdiocese. Members of the Crusade are committed not only to abstain from drinking, but also to help others who struggle with alcohol addiction. Everyone is invited - especially in the month of August - to join the Crusade and abstain from consuming alcoholic beverages.

A special book is placed at the altar of the relics, where everyone is welcomed to write their name.
