The Martyrs' Shrine was built in 1926 to honour our eight Canadian Martyrs, and to carry on the spiritual work, for which the Jesuit Missionaries founded Sainte – Marie among the Hurons in 1639. It was the principal residence for their Mission to the Hurons of Georgian Bay. The six priests all lived at Sainte Marie, and five of them were put to death in that area. At the request of the Canadian Bishop, His Holiness, Pope Pius XII, in 1940, named them secondary patrons of Canada.

August is traditionally declared by the Church in Poland as the month of alcohol abstinence. The Church invites everyone to abstain from alcoholic beverages during the month of August.

**THE LIBERATION CRUSADE** is a voluntary commitment to abstain from alcoholic beverages. The term "crusade" indicates a spiritual battle with evil, where prayer is fundamental. Members of the Crusade are committed not only to abstain from drinking, but also to help others who struggle with alcohol addiction. Everyone is invited - especially in the month of August - to join the Crusade and abstain from consuming alcoholic beverages.

A special book is placed at the altar of the relics, where everyone is welcomed to write their name.

One of life's everyday delights is the smell of a freshly baked load of bread. Besides stirring our appetite, the aroma often conjures up memories: of a grandmother's kitchen, a family feast, a simple meal during travels in a faraway place. Across cultures and throughout history the making and sharing of bread has traditionally been a communal activity that nourishes both body and spirit. In the first reading, Elijah is fortified for his long journey by eating the "cake" which is placed before him. A perfect load of bread may be virtually a work of art, but its primary function is to serve as food. And whether we bite into it, tear it into chunks, or neatly slice it, bread must be broken before it can be eaten. Today, and elsewhere in the Gospels, Jesus identifies himself as the bread of life which is to be broken and shared "for the life of the world." The challenge for us, striving to live as faithful disciples of Jesus, is that we too must be willing to be bread for the world, "broken" in whatever particular ways we are called to be. Let us pray during this Eucharist for the courage to share our bread with others, not only the bread with others, not only the bread from our tables but also the bread of our very lives.
