### ARCHDIOCESE OF TORONTO

The Family of Faith campaign is underway here at St. Maximilian Kolbe.

Our parish, just like all parishes that are part of the Archdiocese of Toronto, is included in the historical initiative "Family of Faith," which aim is to provide financial support to Archdiocese of Toronto. In order to collect the amount needed of 105 million, we need to continue the collection for another three to five years. The main aim of the initiative is to support financially all current needs of the Archdiocese of Toronto, thinking of the future generations. This financial support will include the youth, lay people, catholic publications, as well as St. Michael's Cathedral in Toronto. The Cathedral needs 26 million just for its renovations. Every parish that is part of Archdiocese of Toronto is obliged to take part in this initiative and has a financial goal. Our parish's financial goal has been set for 1.5 million over the next five years. Families that will complete donation declarations but will not be able to continue due to illness etc., will be able to cancel their declaration at any time. **We would like to thank all of our parishioners, who have already declared their financial support. As of today, we have collected: \$666,000.00**
