The Archdiocese of Toronto is standing in the face of new growth and very concrete needs. All parishes of the Archdiocese are participating in the Family of Faith Campaign, which aims to build and strengthen the Catholic community. The Campaign is directed at funding numerous ventures, such as the restoration of St. Michael's Cathedral, which needs \$25 million in renovations. It is also concerned with the preservation of old, historical churches so that they remain part of our Catholic heritage. Furthermore, it wants to ensure the constant presence of chaplains in hospitals and at universities, while funding a variety of pastoral programs.

Our parish of St. Maximilian Kolbe has been tasked with collecting a sum of \$1.5 million. Presently, we have collected \$800,000—a little more than half of the amount.

Nonetheless, on behalf of the Archdiocese of Toronto, we are asking you for your help with the needs facing the local Catholic Church. We are asking you to please pray and respond positively to the request being made of you in the letter you have received.

Please keep in mind that any family that fills out a pledge form but is touched by illness, loss of employment, etc., in the future, will be able to stop their contributions at any time.
