NATIONAL INDEPENDENCE DAY is a national holiday in Poland celebrated every year since 1937 on 11 November to commemorate the anniversary of Poland's assumption of independent statehood in 1918 after 123 years of partition by Russia, Prussia and Austria.

On this same date in Canada, we commemorate REMEMBRANCE DAY in memory of Canadian soldiers who died in the cause of freedom.

DIVINE MERCY YEAR

Pope Francis has announced that the 2016 liturgical year will be an Extraordinary Jubilee Year dedicated to the Divine Mercy. The year will begin on December 8, 2015 with the opening of the Holy Door at St. Peter's Basilica in the Vatican, and will conclude on November 20, 2016 with the liturgical solemnity of Christ the King, and the closing of the Holy Door. On that day, the Church will also be celebrating the 50th anniversary of the closing of the Second Vatican Council. This will be the first time in the history of jubilee years where Holy Doors—Gates of Mercy—will be opened in all dioceses, and especially in cathedrals and selected parishes, and in sanctuaries that have special significance for pilgrims.

ANNIVERSARY OF THE BLESSING OF THE ST. JOHN LATERAN BASILICA - November 9th

St. John Lateran Basilica is the cathedral church of Rome and the official ecclesiastical seat of the Bishop of Rome, who is the Pope.

Officially named *Archibasilica Sanctissimi Salvatoris* ("Archbasilica of the Most Holy Saviour"), it is the oldest and ranks first (being the cathedral of Rome) among the four major basilicas of Rome, and holds the title of ecumenical mother church (mother church of the whole inhabited world) among Roman Catholics.

PRO LIFE - The Pro-Life Group would like to invite everyone for a lecture about the post-abortion syndrome on Monday, November 9th after the evening Mass in St. Maximilian Kolbe Room. It will concentrate on the physical and psychological consequences of abortion, as well as how to talk to those who are not pro-life. The lecture by Martha Crean from The deVeber Institute will include the results of the bio-ethical research.

REMEMBRANCE ENVELOPES

For the departed will be displayed in the narthex of the church. After they have been filled out they can be placed in the box near the altar.

The envelopes will not be read out loud but will be placed near the altar.

Candles may ONLY be lit by the statue of John Paul II. No candles may be lit near the Missionary Cross or by the Divine Mercy monument.

There will be a Mass celebrated every day in the intention of all those mentioned on the remembrance envelopes throughout the entire month of November at Provincial House.

During the month of November the faithful can obtain a plenary indulgence for the Poor Souls in Purgatory, i.e., for a deceased loved one, to assist them on their way to heaven. To obtain an indulgence the faithful must:

1. Visit a church or public oratory on Nov 2nd and pray for the dead saying at least one Our Father and the Creed - OR - Visiting a cemetery between Nov 1st and Nov 8th and praying for the dead,
2. the faithful must receive the sacrament of confession, either eight days before or after the pious act is performed,
3. receive Holy Communion on that day
4. and recite prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father (one Our Father and one Hail Mary is the minimum, but any other additional prayers may be added).
5. All attachment to sin, even venial sin, must be absent. If one's disposition is less than perfect or if some of the above conditions are not fulfilled, the indulgence becomes partial
