her children now live in a beautiful, safe home



THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS - June 3rd & THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY -

June 4th - The Sacred Heart is a religious devotion to Jesus' physical heart as the representation of divine love for humanity. The Feast of the Sacred Heart has been a Solemnity in the Roman Catholic liturgical calendar since 1856. and is celebrated 19 days after Pentecost. As Pentecost is always celebrated on Sunday, the Feast of the Sacred Heart always falls on a Friday. The Immaculate Heart of Mary originally The Sacred Heart of Mary is a devotional name used by Roman Catholics to refer to the physical heart of Mary, the mother of Jesus as a symbol of Mary's interior life, her joys and sorrows, her virtues and hidden perfections, and, above all, her virginal love for her God, her maternal love for her Son, Jesus, and her compassionate love for all.
