God plays a part in the hope and promise that preceded our birth; it is through God's grace that we are blessed with the gift of life each day. Let us pause and consider the wonder of this gift: a gift worthy of praise and thanksgiving.

### MISSION SUNDAY

The Archdiocese of Toronto's Mission Animation Program takes place every year during the summer months. Missionaries from all around the world are invited to each parish, where they proclaim the Word of God, and meet with the faithful. On this occasion, a second collection is taken in support of their pastoral and missionary work. Next weekend, Fr. Marek Ochlak, OMI, a missionary from Madagascar, will be visiting our parish as a part of this program.

Fr. Marek Ochlak was born on March 14, 1966 in Nowe Miasto Lubawskie. Since 1995, he has been working on the Great Red Island of Madagascar, which is a fulfillment of his missionary dreams. Beginning this coming September, he will take over a new mission located in the southwestern part of the Island, in the city of Befasy, in the Diocese of Morondova. There, is only one small church, which functions as the Catholic school, Fr. Marek's home, the church, and the meeting space for the community. Fr. Marek is full of optimism, ready for his new mission. Next Sunday, the second collection will support of the missions in Madagascar.
