Solemnity of the Nativity of the Lord - December 25th

On this day the Church focuses especially on the newborn Child, God become human, who embodies for us all the hope and peace we seek. Christmas Day marks the beginning of the liturgical period of Christmas, rich in signs of God's presence, which will last until January 9 - the Feast of the Baptsim of the Lord.

Feast of St. Stephen -December 26th
