# First Sunday of Advent



A new Beginning! Exciting words – a chance to start over with a clean slate. Who wouldn't relish the possibility of starting over and getting it right? The First Sunday of Advent is the Church's way of announcing the beginning of a new liturgical year - and this Sunday the beginning of the three-year cycle of Sunday readings. Today's readings give us a recipe for how to "get it right," not just for ourselves but for the whole world. Advent is a time of expectant preparation for the celebration of Christmas. We observe it as a season of prayer, fasting and repentance – the ways Christians "start over." In a sense it is also the beginning of the rest of our life. The readings give us the key for how to live in this moment and for all time in peace and harmony. The words of the prophet Isaiah tell of the coming of a judge who will help people from all nations to surrender their weapons and make peace. And in that peace, we are told to choose light over darkness. That light is the coming of Christ, for whom we "must be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an unexpected hour." Exciting? Indeed – a message of hope – the coming of a Savior and the key to preparing for eternity.

# A GIFT FROM THE HEART

Exchanging of gifts during the Christmas season goes back to the baroque era.

The belief was that each gift is a gift from the heart; therefore, even the smallest of gift would provide the receiver with extreme joy.

Since few years ago our parish is sending Christmas gifts to orphanages in Poland. In the previous year, we sponsored "Royal Packages" for children from an orphanage in Klenica, led by Sisters of Our Lady Immaculate Wolsztyn and Pacanow as well as Bydgoszcz. Our parish also supported financially a nursing home in Broniszewice led by Dominican Sisters as well as from Stara Wies and from Czestochowa.

This year we would like to continue with sponsoring Christmas gifts for children and supporting a few chosen orphanages in Poland. On Sunday, December 4<sup>th</sup> there will be an opportunity to make an offering for this cause.

We also remember about those in need in our local community. The Knights of Columbus along with our youth organize food donation for the Mississauga Food Bank.

Non-perishable food items will be collected in the parish hall and by the church entrance next Sunday, December 4<sup>th</sup>.

We don't forget the children. We would like to help Sisters of Life, whose mission is to help mothers with small children, who struggle to get the most basic things for their children: "As for most needed items, we are always in need of more diapers. We particularly need bigger sized diapers (sizes 3,4,5 and 6). For baby boys we are in need of onesies sizes 0-3 months, 9-12 months, 12-18 months and 18-24 months. For baby girls we are in need of onesies sizes 3-6 months, 9-12 months, 12-18 months and 18-24 months."

There will be a special place next Sunday where the above gifts can be placed.

During **the weekend of December 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>**, there will be a collection used for Christmas gifts for children from an orphanage in Poland.
