The Catholic world is celebrating the 100th anniversary of the apparition of Our Lady of Fatima. The celebrations will finish on the 13th of October 2017, marking the 6<sup>th</sup> apparition to the three shepherd children from Fatima.

The Catholic Church officially confirmed the apparition to be authentic 13 years later and Fatima became a place of pilgrimages, conversions and formation of religious vocations.

As is well known, Pope John Paul II immediately thought of consecrating the world to the Immaculate Heart of Mary and he himself composed a prayer for what he called an "Act of Entrustment", which was to be celebrated in the Basilica of Saint Mary Major on 7 June 1981, the Solemnity of Pentecost, the day chosen to commemorate the 1600th anniversary of the First Council of Constantinople and the 1550th anniversary of the Council of Ephesus. Since the Pope was unable to be present, his recorded Address was broadcast.

The following is the part which refers specifically to the Act of Entrustment: "Mother of all individuals and peoples, you know all their sufferings and hopes. In your motherly heart you feel all the struggles between good and evil, between light and darkness, that convulse the world: accept the plea which we make in the Holy Spirit directly to your heart, and embrace with the love of the Mother and Handmaid of the Lord those who most await this embrace, and also those whose act of entrustment you too await in a particular way. Take under your motherly protection the whole human family, which with affectionate love we entrust to you, O Mother. May there dawn for everyone the time of peace and freedom, the time of truth, of justice and of hope".<sup>(3)</sup>

Who can participate in the pilgrimage?

Anyone who has the strength and perseverance can participate in the pilgrimage. We do not, however, encourage elders, those who are sick, those with weak hearts or with very small children to participate. Youth up to 19 years of age may participate in the pilgrimage only after receiving writing permission from their parents or guardians.

What is there to do during the pilgrimage?

Each day is filled with: praying the rosary, conferences, testimonies of the leaders as well as the participants' of the pilgrimage, singing, and conversation. Attendance at morning Mass is mandatory. In the evening there is time for a bonfire, singing and fun, and sometimes even a soccer game.

What do I bring with me on the pilgrimage?

**Supplies:**  
- tent (it's better to share a tent with friends, there is little room on the farm fields and a lot of tents, we must make use of the space we have wisely)  
- warm sleeping bag, blanket  
- propane bottle, metal or plastic dishes and utensils, can opener  
- water bottle  
- cotton socks  
- shirts with sleeves  
- comfortable (not new!) shoes  
- hat  
- raincoat, poncho

**Cosmetics:**  
- sunscreen with UV protection  
- bathroom supplies  
- toilet paper  
- mosquito repellent-basic medicine (pain relievers, band aids, vitamins)

**THE POPE'S MONTHLY PRAYER INTENTIONS JULY 2017**

**LAPSED CHRISTIANS**

That our brothers and sisters who have strayed from the faith, through our prayer and witness to the Gospel, may rediscover the merciful closeness of the Lord and the beauty of the Christian life.



In our times of weariness and need, we can try to find some respite in our support system of close friends and family, in TV shows, shopping, social media and other pastimes. But we may discover that the people and material comforts we depend on cannot truly fill our emptiness and relieve our sufferings. God alone has the boundless love, mercy and compassion to help us bear our crosses. In today's gospel, Jesus encourages those who are weary to come to him to find rest. Though we cannot escape suffering, Jesus assures us that we are not alone in carrying our burdens if we take his yoke and learn from him. The metaphor of the yoke Jesus uses likely refers to a wooden crosspiece used on the necks of two animals as a means of pulling the plough or cart. In this sense, Jesus will carry our crosses with us, side by side, when we cannot bear the load of our sufferings on our own. When the alternative is distress and despair, may we turn to our gracious and merciful God to help us find rest through living and learning Jesus' humble, gentle and compassionate way.
