REMEMBRANCE ENVELOPES

Remembrance envelopes for the departed are located in our parish hall, and should be deposited in the special box by the altar.

During the month of November the faithful can obtain a plenary indulgence for the Poor Souls in Purgatory, i.e., for a deceased loved one, to assist them on their way to heaven. To obtain an indulgence the faithful must:

1. Visit a church or public oratory on Nov 2nd and pray for the dead saying at least one Our Father and the Creed – OR – Visiting a cemetery between Nov 1st and Nov 8th and praying for the dead,
2. the faithful must receive the sacrament of confession, either eight days before or after the pious act is performed,
3. receive Holy Communion on that day
4. and recite prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father (one Our Father and one Hail Mary is the minimum, but any other additional prayers may be added).
5. All attachment to sin, even venial sin, must be absent. If one's disposition is less than perfect or if some of the above conditions are not fulfilled, the indulgence becomes partial.

NATIONAL INDEPENDENCE DAY is a national holiday in Poland celebrated every year since 1937 on November 11th to commemorate the anniversary of Poland's assumption of independent statehood in 1918 after 123 years of partition by Russia, Prussia and Austria.

On this same date in Canada, we commemorate REMEMBRANCE DAY in memory of Canadian soldiers who died in the cause of freedom.
