

The Trinity is a foundational Christian doctrine. It is also difficult to understand. For some it is a math puzzle: how can there be three within one? On the other hand, although most people can correctly state that there are three persons in one God, when they explain what that means, it sometimes sounds like three gods. We are better at saying what the Trinity is not than what it is. It is easier to recognize a challenge to the belief in one God or that there are three within that one God: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Each is distinct from the other, but each is also the same one God. The Bible does not state that there are three persons in one God. But the three persons of the Trinity are frequently found together. Today's Gospel, and excerpt from Jesus' Last Supper discourse, is one such place. The Spirit will come to communicate Jesus' message, not a new one. And since what Jesus has, the Father also has, the Spirit will continue the revelation of the one God. When we worship together, rather than define things, we celebrate them. Thus, we affirm our belief in the Trinity each Sunday in the Creed, as well as when we invoke the Father, Son and Holy Spirit throughout the liturgy.

THE SOLEMNITY **OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY**

Stanislaw Oller, OMI from Madagascar during this weekend.

Fr. Stanislaw was born in Chojnice, Poland. He was ordained in 1981. A year later, Fr. Stanislaw got his obedience to Madagascar. Presently, he works at Volobe, 60km west of Tamatave. There are currently sixty Christian communities totaling 4800 Catholics. It is a very vast mission, the furthest community from the central mission Volobe. Roads do not exist there at all, there are only trails.
