100th Birthday of St. John Paul II
On May 18th, 2020, we will celebrate the 100th anniversary of the birth of Saint John Paul II.



Our parish will mark the beginning of the celebrations with a solemn Mass on **February 2nd at 11 a.m.** The celebrant and homilist will be Fr. Alfred Grzempa OMI, Provincial of Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate. Closing celebrations will take place on the weekend of **May 30th and 31st, 2020.**

On **February 2nd and 9th,** our parish will host an exhibition entitled Eucharistic Miracles, which will show all Eucharistic miracles in the history of the Church. Another is the peregrination of the *Triptych of John Paul II*. The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is an annual ecumenical celebration, traditionally held between January 18th (the Feast of the Confession of Saint Peter) and January 25th (the Feast of the Conversion of Saint Paul).

In the Gospel of John, Christ prays for his disciples before going to the cross. He asks that his followers "may all be one," as he and the Father are one, "so that the world may believe" and have life in his name (John 17). Christian unity is here made central to the very being of the Church and to its mission and witness.

The worldwide celebration of the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is both the seed and the fruit of this striving for 'unity in diversity'. This time of shared prayer, reflection, and fellowship invites Christians of different traditions to deepen our relationships and to live and witness together throughout the year.
