Mercy does not offer love that is convenient, expected or easy; it offers loving care when it is unconventional, over the top or even costly. God has planted this law of mercy inside us: "It is in your mouth and in your heart for you to observe.' May we be so in touch with God dwelling inside each of us that we love generously without counting the cost. May we be more faithful to God's laws than the external rules and customs which become our excuses.

SUMMER TIME RENOVATION

The Finance Committee has decided to renovate the parish hall during the summer vacation. All the walls will be painted, and the carpets will be replaced by a new product called "Looselay Longboard" manufactured by Karndean Design Flooring. The present state of the carpets is lamentable, despite the fact that they are cleaned once a month. Coffee spills, crumbs from food etc. leave stains which are hard to clean. The Looselay Longboard will be more hygienic and easier to keep clean. Karndean has a non-porous surface, meaning that dirt, bacteria, and moisture will not penetrate and remain in it.

At the same time, we request that nothing be hung on the walls, no posters, pamphlets or advertising, as tape will ruin the walls. Groups which will not adhere to these new rules will lose the privilege of selling donuts (paczki).

Who can participate in the pilgrimage?

Anyone who has the strength and perseverance can participate in the pilgrimage. We do not, however, encourage elders, those who are sick, those with weak hearts or with very small children to participate. Youth up to 19 years of age may participate in the pilgrimage only after receiving writing permission from their parents or guardians.

What is there to do during the pilgrimage?

Each day is filled with: praying the rosary, conferences, testimonies of the leaders as well as the participants' of the pilgrimage, singing, and conversation. Attendance at morning Mass is mandatory. In the evening there is time for a bonfire, singing and fun, and sometimes even a soccer game.

What do I bring with me on the pilgrimage? Supplies:

- tent (it's better to share a tent with friends, there is little room on the farm fields and a lot of tents, we must make use of the space we have wisely)

- warm sleeping bag, blanket

- propane bottle, metal or plastic dishes and utensils, can opener

water bottle

- cotton socks

- shirts with sleeves

- snirts with sleeves - comfortable (not new!) shoes -hat

- raincoat, poncho


Cosmetics:
