They are to trust this new way of life where love accepts generously the gifts of others and ministers to the sick. Yet when the disciples return, they rejoice. Why? Perhaps they have come to experience and see that out of so little so much is being given. Jesus knows the suffering of God's people is great. He knows our needs require his love and mercy to heal a suffering world. Jesus calls us to discipleship – to be his body, his hands, his heart to care, to listen and to love in a way that serves and reveals the kingdom of God. We are asked to trust in this new way of being: giving ourselves to Jesus' love when we respond to the needs of others. We have a choice: will we voiceless bystanders in our world or trusting, rejoicing bearers of the mercy and love of God?

## SUMMER TIME **RENOVATION**

The Finance Committee has decided to renovate the parish hall during the summer vacation. All the walls will be painted, and the carpets will be replaced by a new product called "Looselay Longboard" manufactured by Karndean Design Flooring. The present state of the carpets is lamentable, despite the fact that they are cleaned once a month. Coffee spills, crumbs from food etc. leave stains which are hard to clean. The Looselav Longboard will be more hygienic and easier to keep clean. Karndean has a non-porous surface, meaning that dirt, bacteria, and moisture will not penetrate and remain in it.

At the same time, we request that nothing be hung on the walls, no posters, pamphlets or advertising, as tape will ruin the walls. Groups which will not adhere to these new rules will lose the privilege of selling donuts (paczki).

# **Rosary Garden**

Presently, our Rosary Garden is undergoing renovation. The Stations of the Cross as well as the Mysteries of the Rosary stations were in very bad shape, not having been tended to for several years. The cost of renovating each Station is \$400, resulting in a total cost of \$12,000.

# **SUMMER** TIME

A gentle reminder for the upcoming summer months: Each Catholic has the obligation to participate in the Sunday Eucharist. Vacations, cottage trips, or other activities and/or travel do not provide valid exemption from participation. Voluntarily missing Mass is a grave sin. Canon 1247 does not only state the obligation for the faithful to participate in Mass on Sundays and other Holy Days of Obligation, but also for the faithful to abstain from works and affairs which hinder the worship to be rendered to God, the joy proper to the Lord's Day, or the suitable relaxation of mind and body. Furthermore, the Catechism of the Catholic Church (no. 2181) clearly states: "Those who deliberately fail in this obligation commit a grave sin."

There may come to be, however situations which provide exemption from regular participation in the Sunday Eucharist. According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church (no. 2181) these include only serious reasons, such as illness or the care of infants. Otherwise, dispensation from participation in the Mass may be obtained from one's own pastor.

Radio, television, and the Internet may facilitate participation for those prevented in taking part in the Holy Mass, especially if accompanied by the service of extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist.

### 75<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE WARSAW UPRISING
