Earthly riches can weaken our ability to see and understand the suffering of others. Today's Gospel offers a proud rich man whose spiritual awareness is closed to the needs of the poor man, Lazarus. He has become locked in a life of ease. For all the good he might have done, the rich man's love of money made him morally unresponsive. In this parable, Jesus makes it clear that we have the spiritual help we need to resist the temptation of pride. There are the words of the prophet Amos warning that wealth tempts people to think only of themselves. More importantly, through the Ten Commandments we are directed to respond righteously to others, especially the poor. Not surprisingly, then, Father Abraham rebukes the rich man with the powerful truth, telling him these spiritual laws and instructions are the firm basis on which to seek salvation. Fortunately, Jesus offers a parable that shows being merciful and loving can help us overcome temptation. Indeed, reflecting on God's divine love for us is the best place to start. To reduce the suffering of others by our acts of compassion is a fitting response to God's splendid gift.

St Louis Marie Grignon de Montfort was a priest and writer living in France (1673-1716).

He zealously propagated the idea of consecrating oneself to Jesus through Mary. He created a 33 Spiritual Program in preparation for the Act of Consecration to Jesus through Mary.

The Perfect Consecration to Jesus Christ  
 A complete consecration to Mary

As all perfection consists in our being conformed, united and consecrated to Jesus it naturally follows that the most perfect of all devotions is that which conforms, unites, and consecrates us most completely to Jesus. Now of all God's creatures Mary is the most conformed to Jesus. It therefore follows that, of all devotions, devotion to her makes for the most effective consecration and conformity to him. The more one is consecrated to Mary, the more one is consecrated to Jesus.

That is why perfect consecration to Jesus is but a perfect and complete consecration of oneself to the Blessed Virgin, which is the devotion I teach; or in other words, it is the perfect renewal of the vows and promises of holy baptism.

This devotion consists in giving oneself entirely to Mary in order to belong entirely to Jesus through her. It requires us to give:

- ◆ Our body with its senses and members;
- ◆ Our soul with its faculties;
- ◆ Our present material possessions and all we shall acquire in the future;
- ◆ Our interior and spiritual possessions, that is, our merits, virtues and good actions of the past, the present and the future.

In other words, we give her all that we possess both in our natural life and in our spiritual life as well as everything we shall acquire in the future in the order of nature, of grace, and of glory in heaven. This we do without any reservation, not even of a penny, a hair, or the smallest good deed. And we give for all eternity without claiming or expecting, in return for our offering and our service, any other reward than the honour of belonging to our Lord through Mary and in Mary, even though our Mother were not—as in fact she always is—the most generous and appreciative of all God's creatures.

**Parishioners who are interested in total giving of oneself in Christ and for Christ, through love, in the Immaculate Heart of Mary according to St. Louis Marie Grignon de Montfort, and taking part in the Consecration to Jesus Christ are invited to participate fully in the Marian Retreat as well as attend Holy Mass on Sunday, October 6<sup>th</sup> at 11:00, during which we will read together the Act of Consecration.**
