# **Divine Mercy Sunday**



What a gift faith is and how personal its lessons are! John's Gospel account reveals how Thomas, as with the other disciples, seeks the reassurance of the risen Christ for what he believes and cherishes. After encountering Jesus in the locked room, the once-forlorn disciple experiences transformation and joy to realize the truth - that Jesus presents himself and calls, uniquely, to each of them to follow him. With all that we can speculate about the feelings of Thomas, it is his embrace of the close and reassuring knowledge of God's love which confirms his faith.

Fittingly, Thomas found his faith by rejoining his fellow disciples. He was active in searching his heart for the truth and for making it possible to recognize that what he believed was a conviction of his belief. Small wonder, then, that in the earliest days of the Christian community described in the Acts of the Apostles, the disciples conduct their mission with zeal, tangibly feeling the blessing of Christ's gifts of grace to them and the certainty, as the psalm exhorts, that "his love endures forever."

When trial threatens to overwhelm our tolerance, active belief in the divine love of God endures as the solution. Christ imbues us with graces in answer to prayers, and, as with Thomas, responds intuitively to our need to be sustained in faith.

### **Divine Mercy Sunday**

On the first Sunday after Easter, the Catholic Church celebrates **Divine Mercv Sunday**, a feast day established by St. John Paul II. The cult of Divine Mercy is associated with the apparitions experienced by St. Faustina Kowalska, to whom Jesus appeared in 1935, recommending that she spread the message of God's Mercy to the whole world. On August 17th, 2002, during a pilgrimage to Poland, John Paul II entrusted the whole world to God's Mercy and blessed the Shrine in Kraków Łagiewniki.

There are millions of worshipers of God's Mercy around the world. In April 1993, John Paul II beatified Sister Faustina Kowalska and announced her feast day; she was canonized on April 30th, 2000. "I am love and mercy alone," said Jesus and asked Sister Faustina to spread this message to the whole world. The Lord Jesus pointed out to Sister Faustina five ways in which people can ask for salvation for themselves and the whole world: • praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet; • praying before the image of Merciful Jesus with the inscription Jesus, I trust in You; • praying at the hour of Christ's death on the cross, called the Hour Of Mercy (3 p.m.); • celebrating the Feast of Mercy; • spreading the worship of God's Mercy through prayer, word and action. Today at 5:30 p.m. we will pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet. Please join us.

For those who were unable to secure a spot for Mass in the church but participated in it virtually, Holy Communion will be distributed on Sunday, April 11th at 4:30 p.m. and 5 **p.m.** in the church. Face masks are mandatory.

#### **COVID-19 and Our Parish**

- Churches in the Region of Peel continue to be open at 15% capacity (250 individuals) and faithful can participate in Mass. Face masks are mandatory inside all church buildings.

- All most up-to-date information is always communicated at the end of Mass. Please listen carefully.
- Weddings and funerals are restricted to 15% of the church capacity. Baptisms take place outside of Mass and are also restricted to 15% of church capacity.
- No meetings are taking place in parish halls or other church spaces at this time. The only exception are essential services, e.g., A.A.
- First Communion and Confirmation classes continue to take place virtually and will stay in this format for as long as the Region of Peel remains in a grey zone. If anything changes, we will inform all parents.
