In today's Gospel we are privy to a conversation Jesus has with a Pharisee. Amidst the debaters whose agenda is to trap Jesus, this one Pharisee reveals his heart with the acknowledgement of the first commandment. Jesus affirms the man's faith. This declaration establishes the boundaries of the kingdom of God. The debaters back off and are afraid to ask Jesus any more questions. They refuse to love God who is standing in front of them.

It has been said that to say yes to one thing is to say no to a thousand others. Our decision to worship God with everything in us means saying no to the world. St. Augustine said, "Love God and do what you will." Our commitment to the Lord is in response to the amazing love he has shown us. In the Eucharist we truly immerse ourselves in the divine relationship with the communion of saints. All the gifts of heaven resonate within us. Dorothy Day once said she never attended a boring mass. She was right.

As we live this commitment to the Lord our God, our path is clear – perhaps not easy, but definitely in the Godzone.

## Wypominki

The church prays for all the faithful departed, especially in November, when we join together to pray for those who repent in Purgatory. They need the prayers of the living to shorten the period of penance and unite with God in heaven. The souls of the dead can no longer do anything about their cause, and therefore need the prayers of the living. One of the forms of help we can offer them is through *wypominki* – where we list the names of our departed family and friends on memorial envelopes and the Church community prays for them. Additionally, in the month of November, 30 Masses are celebrated for the repose of their souls. Memorial envelopes can be found at each entrance to the church. They can be deposited into a special box found on the steps of the sanctuary.

Please note that since outdoor social gatherings and organized public events are capped at 100 people, there will be no prayers at local cemeteries this year. However, you are still encouraged to visit a cemetery and pray for the faithful departed. **As a parish community, we will pray for the deceased from November 1<sup>st</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m. (before the evening Mass).**

## – OTHER NEWS –

Our church is open for in-person celebrations. All Masses are held indoors.

• For sacramental celebrations, in Step 3, there is no capacity limit for places of worship. However, physical distancing of 2 metres is still required between parishioners attending Mass who are not from the same household.

• **Livestreaming** of services and dispensation from physical participation in the Sunday Eucharist continues. The elderly, those with compromised immune systems or other health conditions should be encouraged to exercise extreme caution about any outings, including attendance at church.

• **Funerals** take place from Monday to Friday in the morning.

• **Baptisms** take place outside of Mass, on Saturday mornings.

• **Meetings** in parish halls or other indoor spaces are permitted in Step 3. Attendance may not exceed 50% of meeting space capacity. Participants must be masked and physically distanced. In addition, a sign-in sheet for meetings should be provided for the purposes of contact tracking. Meals and food services at meetings is discouraged at this time.

• **Most up-to-date information** is always communicated at the end of Mass. Please listen carefully.

• When leaving a message on the parish answering machine, remember to include your name and phone number.

• **Local municipal by-laws remain in place – the use of face masks inside all public places is still in effect, even for those who are fully vaccinated.**
