Carefully unroll it, place the slotted ends of the sticks into string loops glued into place on the outer seam of the flattened diamondshaped paper, then tie string where the sticks crossed and – voila – you had a kite. Add some long strips of sheet from your mother's rag bin for a tail, then off the park.

The spring breeze caught the kites as we ran. Our spirits soared along with our paper flyers. Anything seemed possible for us. Hope and joy abounded. "We were all made to drink of the Spirit."

Somewhere along our lives' path, fear joined us; care wore us down. Dreams dimmed. Like those women and men gathered together so long ago, we also worry about what will become of us. Like them we need to hear a sound "like a rush of a violent wind" and see, as they did, "divided tongues, as of fire." The Spirit touched them, breaking the bonds of their fear. It touches us too!
