Our ministry tagline may not be original, but it is a sequel to the first invitation to food for body and soul found in the Gospel of John.

Today's Gospel offers the source of that food and it is Jesus. Earlier in John's Gospel, some disciples complain; in today's text, they dispute among themselves, asking how this can be. What is meant to unite us can cause division, even today. How do I approach the table? Who else comes to the table with me? When disputes arise, we must not lose sight of the gift and the Giver. Jesus offers us not only living bread but eternal life.


