3rd Sunday of Advent



Reflection

It's GAUDATE (REJOICE) Sunday, and Christmas Eve most of today's readings shimmer and pulsate Christmas Day with joy. It's the Gospel that, at first blush, St. Stephen seems anti-climactic, as an ascetic John the Baptist preaches sacrifice to those wishing to receive his baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. And yet there are three causes of rejoicing here that can also transform our lives.

The first is the stirring of desire for a holy life from such unlike characters as tax collectors, soldiers and, well, ordinary people. The second is their humble, courageous and fearsome question: "What should we do?" They so longed for the forgiveness of their sins that wealth, power and position faded away before the promise of a clean heart. And John's response - his good news - was within their reach: act fairly and honestly. But the greatest cause for rejoicing is the glimpse John gave of the Saviour coming to baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire: a baptism of holiness beyond their comprehension and beyond his own grace.

As we approach the Advent of our Lord into the very marrow of our humanity, wishing away our sins and promising a baptism into his divinity, let us muster the hope and the audacity to ask, "What must I do, to open my heart to this grace today?"

The film tells the story of extraordinary events that took place in the summer of 1877 in the Warmia village of Gietrzwałd (then Dietrichswalde under Prussian rule). These are the only apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Poland whose authenticity has been canonically confirmed (by the decree of Bp. Drzazga in 1977).
