Reflection

As did the apostles, today we turn our eyes towards the heavens as we ponder Christ’s Ascension. And it is good to remind ourselves sometimes that this life is not the only one. Caught up in our daily concerns, we can sometimes forget there is more to life than what we experience in this world. Jesus’ Ascension reminds us to set our sights higher, to an eternity with God.

Lest we lose ourselves in heaven-gazing, though, the message of the angels in today’s first reading brings us firmly back to earth. “Why do you stand looking up toward heaven?” Yes, we hope in the world to come. At the same time, we must remember that it is this world that Jesus came to redeem. And it is to this world that he calls each of us to proclaim, by our words and our actions, his message of life over death, love over hate, hope over despair.

And so we live, in a way, with one foot in heaven, the other on earth. Knowing the Risen One, we place our hope in an eternity of peace and joy. In the meantime, we do everything in our power to bring the reality of God’s kingdom into our own world here and now. Like the apostles, we go forth today filled with joy to proclaim the Good News with our lives.
