Reflection

With Trinity Sunday we have the opportunity to name the spiritual intensity of the past nine weeks. Starting with Palm Sunday, we have realized the boundless love of God the Son through the Passion of Resurrection of Christ Jesus. We have celebrated the glorious welcome of God the Father with the Ascension of the Son from earth into heaven. And we have received anew the out-pouring of God the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.

One conclusion of the Paschal Mysteries is that the identity of God – the Almighty, the Immortal and the Living – is far beyond human understanding. The Church Fathers named this “Trinity,” the divine relationship of the Three-in-One. This identity points to the “much more I have to tell you, but now it would be too much for you to know” that Jesus refers to in today’s Gospel. It also reveals an underlying theme of Scripture – that “all that the Father has,” which is Jesus’ to give and the Holy Spirit’s to declare to us, is omnipresent.

Will we casually celebrate this Solemnity today, and carry on as if the Trinity is too enigmatic, too infinite and too intimidating to engage in real life? Or going forward in Ordinary Time, will we truly live into the enlivening and divine relationship named The Holy Trinity that we are called to embrace, day by day?

This Sunday, the Church celebrates the solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. “The Most Holy Trinity is a central doctrine in Christianity, describing the nature of God as three distinct persons in one divine essence: God the Father, God the Son (Jesus Christ), and God the Holy Spirit. Each person is fully and equally God, yet there is only one God, not three. This mystery reflects God’s relational nature, where the Father creates, the Son redeems, and the Holy Spirit sanctifies. The feast of the Most Holy Trinity, celebrated on the Sunday after Pentecost, invites believers to reflect on the profound mystery of God’s unity and diversity, and His active presence in the world.” (Martyrs’ Shrine)

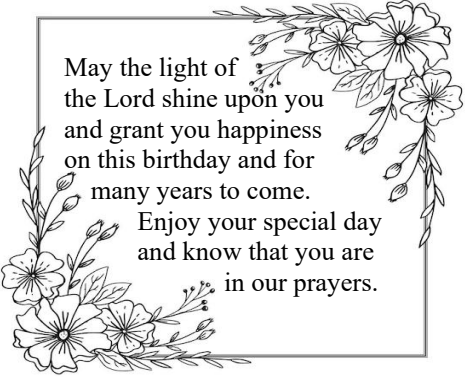
