Reflection

Genuine faith must be an immensely powerful force for a seed-sized bit to be enough to uproot a shrub and plant it in the sea: to command the forces of nature. Yet that is what Jesus directly tells the disciples in today's Gospel. The fruit of our inheritance as God's children is to do great things with him when we have the smallest bit of faith.

Through faith, God generously shares his creative life with us, in love and for the sake of love. Through faith, we participate in Jesus' mission. And when our faith is seen by others, it can be a light shining in the darkness that gives hope and courage.

I remember the winter night when strangers knocked on our farmhouse door, waking the household. Their car was stuck far from a town. They had seen a light in our window and walked across the fields to reach safety, warmth and help. They could have died in the cold that night, long before cellphones. But they saw a beacon, a simple nightlight kept for a sick child. It was enough to guide them to life.

If we have faith the size of a nightlight, we can show the way to those who are lost; we can bring hope to those who are in darkness and deadly fear; and we can reveal God's love.
